# Color Wheel Mandala

### Regular Art

**Grade Level**: 7th-8th Grade **Time Period**: 2-3 in class days

Goal/Objectives:

★ To create an artwork using a radial/mandala design

★ To understand the element of color and color wheel order

★ To understand how colors relate to one another

★ To improve use of colored pencils and blending skills

### Vocabulary:

- Color
- Radial
- Primary
- Secondary
- Tertiary
- Tint
- Shade

#### Materials:

- 12" x 12" white drawing paper
- Ruler
- Pencil
- Colored pencils
- Blending technique sheet/worksheet
- Thin sharpie marker

## Steps:

- 1. Review the color wheel mandala slideshow on google classroom.
- Complete small color wheel drawing (placing colors in correct spots), and a rough draft idea of what your mandala will look like - 12 sections total
- 3. Options for designing your mandala....
  - a. Use the triangle template to draw your design once and then trace that design through your paper 12 times see slide #10
  - b. OR Divide final paper into 12 sections see slide #11 (this may not relate to you if your design is different.

- 4. Begin lightly drawing in designs for mandala in PENCIL.
- 5. Begin adding color to each section of mandala making sure it is in color wheel order, there is a tint of each color, and a shade of each color..
- 6. Add thin sharpie or black pen outlines if your design could use it.
- 7. Erase any leftover pencil lines.
- 8. Sign the bottom right corner of the artwork.
- 9. Complete the ARTIST STATEMENT slideshow & add a photo to the 2nd side.
- 10. Turn in slideshow to the correct assignment for a grade.
