Substitute Plans for October 4, 2011 (TWO SIDES)

- 1. Take Roll with seating chart (binder) Send absent list to office for first period.
- 2. Read Announcements
- 3. Pass out Pictures (students may view them for 30 seconds after everyone gets them, then put them away.
- 4. Language Arts/Social Studies 7 Core 1 (Per ½) and Core 2 (Per 3/6)
 - a. Journal (20ish minutes)
 - i. Write a Full Page based on a variation of the prompt on board allow 15 minutes MAX.
 - ii. Share 3 4 max entries in class
 - iii. Collect journals of all student present, regardless if completed or not.

b. Stations -

- i. Students were assigned station numbers yesterday see roll sheet "Stations 1007"
- ii. Core 1 Students should start at the second station today.
 - 1. Students MUST MOVE into the group seats as follows:
 - a. If group 1 was at station 1 yesterday, then today they start at station 2.
 - b. Give groups about 20 minutes to work at each station THEN
 - c. Move to the next station. Group 1 would be at Station 3.
 - d. After 20 more minutes, there is 20 minutes or so left, then group should move to the next station. Group 1 would be at Station 4.
 - i. If there is not enough time for the third station then:
 - e. If students finish station work early, they should work on work from previous stations already visited.
 - 2. Station suggestions
 - a. Station 2 Read Stargirl, should happen outside in the hall.
 - b. Station 3 may use the computers in the back of room.
 - c. Allow groups to discuss work, but not engage in general discussion.
 - d. All other groups must work to complete as much work as they can.
- iii. Core 2 (Period 3 6)
 - 1. Start with Journal sequence above.
 - 2. Stations should finish Second Station by moving to that station. Thus, Group 1 should start at Station Two.
 - 3. Give students 10 minutes to work at this station.
 - 4. Students should switch to the third station, thus Group 1 should now move to Station Three.
 - 5. Students should stay at Station Three until the end of period 3.
 - 6. When students return for period 6, they should move to Station Four.
 - 7. If students are done early at any station, they should work on previous station assignments, or they may read or do homework.
- 5. Period 5 SSR and Photojournalism
 - a. At the beginning of this class, tell students they will be doing homework during the regular class period.
 - b. They must read a novel the entire SSR period until 1:23 pm.

100711 Station assignment notes – from in class discussion:

- 1. Poetry Assignment:
 - a. Write a poem that using dialogue between two people
 - b. Pick and focus on a very specific topic using the One Inch Picture Frame
 - c. The poem should force the reader to identify feelings, senses and/or emotions that are demonstrated in the poem
 - d. 12 lines minimum, most likely 20 30 lines

2. Calendar Activity –

- a. Each group member must take bullet point notes that cover
 - i. the major traits of the assigned calendar, and
 - ii. contrast it with our current 365 ¼ day Solar Calendar.
 - iii. What are the major cycles of each calendar.
 - iv. How often do the lunar calendars match up with the solar calendars.
 - v. How is the first day of each month computed.
 - vi. Important holidays New Year, Month long, Spring, Fall, Winter, etc.
 - vii. Define other important features of the calendar.
 - viii. ALL GROUPS print max a different article per member and USE BOOKS and textbooks
