RSVP EXPECTATIONS / NO-SHOW POLICY

When you RSVP to attend an event, you are making a commitment and are expected to show up. However, we realize that an unforeseen conflict may subsequently arise and, if so, you are expected to immediately change your RSVP to “Not Going”.

The typical no-show is someone who was confirmed to an event from a Waitlist. Therefore, if you are on a Waitlist please be watchful for a Meetup message/notification that you have been moved to the Going list. Even better - periodically check your status on the event page directly. If you clear a Waitlist and are no longer able to attend, please change your status to “Not Going”. Likewise, if you are on a Waitlist and have made other plans, please remove yourself from the Waitlist.

When an event is booked full, a no-show deprives another member the opportunity to attend which is inconsiderate and rude. Don't be THAT person!

WARNING! No-shows will be marked as such on their Attendance History which is visible to event organizers. Someone with a no-show history may be removed from the Going List for a future event. Repeat no-shows may be banned from the group.
