STAY INFORMED

BAND App

We use the BAND App for most of our daily communication. BAND App is a group platform that helps us communicate and plan our schedule. It works like other social media platforms, where you can upload photos, videos and chat; but the biggest difference is it's only for our group and it's monitored and safe! The Sound of Central Marching Band

Membership in the marching band requires strenuous physical activity and the ability to play difficult musical literature. In order to build upper body strength, stamina, and breath support, members will be given sets of 10 push-ups or crunches, from staff and/or student leaders.

THE BAND RULES

- 1. TREAT EVERYONE WITH KINDNESS AND RESPECT.
- 2. STOP WHEN THE DIRECTOR SAYS "STOP."
- **3. NO GUM, food or drinks.** Only water is allowed during rehearsals.
- 4. Wear tennis shoes and socks at marching band practices.
- 5. No cell phones during rehearsals..
- 6. Be On Time. "Calltime" is when you need to be in your seat.
- 7. Keep a uniform look when performing. No visible jewelry or excessive makeup.
- 8. Only band members in the bandroom when we are in uniform.

BAND MEMBERS SHOULD

- Come to rehearsal with a GOOD ATTITUDE.
- Make a real effort to improve everyday and establish a good practice routine.
- Put all materials in their proper place.
- Be extra-careful with instruments and keep in good shape. Repair costs are high!
- Keep your grades up in all classes.
- Take responsibility for your mistakes. We all make them.
- Practice how you perform.

Home Football Games

- Sit in the stands in your section. No visitors will be allowed to sit within the band block.
- Always keep your eyes on the Drum Major and listen for instructions.
- Be careful with equipment and of others moving in and out of the stands. Remember, you are responsible for any damage you have caused, even if it was an accident.
- No food or drink in the stands at football games, except the 3rd quarter break.
- Everyone will be given a 3rd quarter break for food. You must be back in the stands when the scoreboard clock shows 1:00 minute left in the 3rd quarter. Anyone returning late will remain in the stands during the third quarter of the next football game.

Pep Band

Sometimes we travel to away games using one bus for cost saving measures. Seating is limited and consideration will be given to overall band balance and seniority. Therefore, the pep band usually consists of upperclassmen from each section, all drumline members, and all senior band members and staff. Colorguard and pit are rarely involved with Pep Band.

How Parents Can Help

- Communicate with the director if the student will be absent from rehearsal.
- Check behind the student to make sure that they have what they need to be successful.
- Have your child picked up from rehearsals on time by working out carpools with other parents.
- Visit rehearsals and attend concerts, games, and competitions.

Policies and Expectations

ATTENDANCE POLICY

EXCELLENT BANDS ARE MADE UP OF MEMBERS WHO HAVE A COMMITMENT TO FAITHFUL ATTENDANCE. Attendance at all band functions (practices, football games, parades, etc.) is mandatory, unless specified otherwise. Exceptions to this rule will be limited to family emergencies or other extenuating circumstances and will be decided on an individual basis by the director. In the event of a family emergency, the director must be notified by the parents. UNEXCUSED MISSED PERFORMANCE WILL RESULT IN REMOVAL FROM THE PROGRAM! The only excusable absences are pre-arranged school conflicts and those that would be excused by the school for attendance records. You will always have the dates of performances well in advance. Work is NOT an excuse for an absence! You can't expect your employer to work around your band commitments if you don't give them our schedule in advance. Be responsible - avoid hassles.

*Students must fill out an absentee form if they know they will miss a practice. These forms will be kept on file and reviewed as necessary. For illness, a parent note or doctor's excuse may be requested.

Dress Code

The dress code for performances and practices will follow the Chesterfield County Schools dress code for students: "Students are expected to be clean and neat each day ... Clothing on the upper body must completely cover the shoulder with only the arms exposed..."

Some example of unacceptable attire include the following:

NETTED JERSEY TOPS WITHOUT AN UNDERSHIRT, HALTERS, OPEN BACK DRESSES OR SHIRTS, SHEER DRESSES OR SHIRTS, OPEN BACK MIDRIFF SHIRTS, TANK TOPS, LEOTARDS, TIGHTS, SKIN-TIGHT CLOTHING, SAGGING PANTS, SUGGESTIVE WRITING ON CLOTHES. NO "SHORT" SHORTS.

JUDGMENT OF QUESTIONABLE DRESS WILL BE MADE ON A CASE-BY-CASE BASIS. TATTOOS SHOULD BE LIMITED TO INSIDE YOUR EYELIDS. BOTTOM OF FEET, AND UNDER YOUR TONGUE.

TRAVEL ON BUSES

District policy concerning bus travel will apply on all field trips: Remain in your seat at all times. Males and females (or couples) will not be permitted to share seats on the bus. Boys and girls are required to sit on opposite sides of the bus isles. No inappropriate games, music, or language. Total silence at RXR crossings. The bus driver has final authority on bus matters. The District, School, and band program <u>are not</u> responsible for lost or stolen items. Members must <u>travel to events</u> with the group on buses. Students may leave with parents. Students who leave with their parents are responsible for securing their instrument, uniform, and any other property.

RECURRING FIELD TRIP PERMISSION FORM

Parents, your child's involvement with the band requires many trips on the bus. All special activity trip regulations, local school rules, as well as the Chesterfield County Schools Student Code of Conduct will be enforced. The school will take every precaution to provide for the safety of your child on each trip. You are requested to sign a single form (located in the back of the Bandbook) to grant permission for your child to attend and participate throughout the school year.

Uniforms

Provided By The BAND

Marching Uniform (Bibbers, Coat, & accessories, Hat & Plume), Show shirt, sweat, lyres, flip folders, body odor, repairs, sticks, heads, a lifetime of wonderful memories, ligatures, sheet music.

Marching Uniforms

We wear full uniform for important events, marching competitions, and home varsity football games. "Full uniform" consists of bibbers, jacket, dickie, tie, gauntlets, tail, gloves. Uniforms are cleaned and fitted during band camp.

Show Shirt

The show shirt is unique every year. We will wear these as part of the summer uniform, under our full uniform and to school on Fridays. This is covered by the band fee.

STUDENTS MUST PROVIDE

White Shorts (Augusta Long Length Wicking Short W/Pocket - AG803)
All students will need to purchase a specific pair of uniform shorts. These are your shorts to wear whenever you'd like. You can have your name, the band logo, c/o '25, section, or leadership title put on them. We will use these shorts every year. Shorts can be ordered or purchased from Rivers Graphics in Pageland.

Red Shoes- Chuck Taylor All Star Classic All students will need a pair of red high-top Chuck Taylors. These are yours and can be worn anytime, but must be kept neat and clean.

Summer Uniform

This includes the show shirt and white shorts. We will wear the "Summer Uniform" for public performances in the southern heat.

School Colors

"School Colors" refers to any style shirt that represents Central High School colors and... "your Reds." We dress in "School Colors" for away games and some performances.

INSTRUMENT STORAGE SECURITY

Every effort is made to provide a safe and orderly environment for the storing of instruments and equipment, both private and school owned. However, belongings kept in the band room are there at your own risk. Neither the School nor the District has insurance coverage for private possessions stored in our facilities. Even though we do not anticipate problems, we can avoid these if students will lock their cases, monitor persons entering storage areas, and report unusual activity to the band director. The director retains the right to use any instrument in the bandroom at their own discretion.

FINANCIAL OBLIGATIONS

Band fees cover the basic costs of marching band such as travel and instrument repairs (which are two of our biggest expenses) as well as music, drill, flip folders, lyres, reeds, valve oil, ect. The total band fee is \$150. \$50 marching deposit is due May 22nd to secure your child's spot. The band fee can be paid in full or broken into these payments:

\$50 May 22, 2025 \$50 Aug. 1, 2025 \$50 Oct. 1, 2025


