## **MATERIALS AND METHODS (12pt, left, bold, UPPERCASE)**

**Ethical clearance** refers to a statement indicating that the research has obtained **official approval from an authorized ethics committee**, confirming that the study complies with established ethical standards and does not violate research ethics.

Initial paragraphs made indented, manuscripts are written using **Times New Roman 12, single space**. Materials and methods must contain full explanation of research material including procedural testing, analysis, biology, and statistics used. Modifications to the procedure must be clearly explained so that it can be used by other researchers. The study conditions must be clearly explained, such as the feed used, the conditions of the test animals (breed, sex, age), the conditions of the study site, the measurement data, and the equipment used.

Author must describe the products and tools that used in research. Statistical analysis method must be in accordance with research. The researcher must explain the statistical model, experimental unit, and hypothesis clearly.


