

Key facts:

73% of parents supported the motion, 12% opposed it.

Results from the captain's meeting were split evenly for and against the motion.

Results from the council forum were: 149 students for the motion, and 38 students against the motion.

The majority of coaches were against the motion. More details can be found in the attachment.

Original Motion

I move that the school adopt a policy to limit athletic practices and games (optional and non-optional) during school vacations. Any scheduled practices or games would take place for no more than half the total days of the break (including weekends) and must allow for consecutive days of vacation.

Our Current motion

I move that the school adopt a policy to limit athletic practices and games (optional and non-optional) during school vacations. School sports will allow for two consecutive days of no scheduled practices or games during Thanksgiving and February break, and three consecutive days during Holiday and April break.
