

Spring 2022 CHS AP Testing Information



AP tests are around the corner! Here are some friendly reminders:

- The College Board requires all students to read the [AP Exam Terms and Conditions](#) prior to test date. Students are bound to these terms and conditions and are required to sign on their answer sheet that they have read this information.
- Monday, May 2nd is a teacher workday, but the AP US Government exam is still scheduled for that day at 8am. Students must arrive no later than 7:30am.
- Students with a morning exam must arrive to their testing location no later than 7:30am; students with an afternoon exam must arrive no later than 11:30am. There is no late entry.
- Most exam administrations last about 3 ½ hours. Please plan accordingly. There are no late buses so students with an afternoon exam should make prior arrangements for transportation.
- Consider bringing a small snack and drink to access during your break. Students cannot access electronic devices at any time during the exam administration. **IF YOU HAVE 2 EXAMS ON THE SAME DAY, bring a snack.** There will not be time to leave campus or go to the cafeteria in between exams.
- Bring at least (3) #2 pencils and pens with black or blue ink. No mechanical pencils are allowed. For exams that allow an approved calculator, students are highly encouraged to bring a calculator. Highlighters are not permitted.
- Students are not required to attend classes on the day of their exam; however, students are responsible for making up any missed assignments. Please communicate with your teacher ahead of time if you will be out of class for testing. Students who plan to arrive late or leave early on the day of their exam(s) must get the attached permission slip signed and returned to Student Services.
- Exam dates and times are assigned by the College Board. If you work, make arrangements ahead of time with your workplace. Athletes, let your coach know if you will miss a practice and/or game. Students cannot leave exams before the end of the testing period.
- Get good sleep the night before your exam! :)
- Eat breakfast the morning of your exam.
