Position Duties/Responsibilities:

- Conduct ski or snowboard lessons for individuals and groups of varying ages and abilities.
- Assess the skill level of students and tailor instruction accordingly, focusing on technique, safety, and progression.
- Demonstrate proper skiing or snowboarding techniques and provide hands-on guidance to help students improve their skills.
- Ensure the safety of students at all times by adhering to resort policies and procedures and maintaining awareness of terrain and weather conditions.
- Communicate effectively with students to provide clear instructions and feedback, encouraging a supportive and motivating learning environment.
- Assist with the organization and coordination of lesson schedules, equipment rentals, and other logistical aspects of instruction.
- Stay informed about current industry standards, teaching methodologies, and safety practices, and participate in training sessions and workshops as required.
- Provide excellent customer service by addressing guest inquiries, resolving concerns, and promoting a positive image of the resort.
- Maintain a professional appearance and demeanor while representing the resort both on and off the slopes.
- Perform other duties as assigned.

Guest Service/Conduct:

Personal and professional accountability is an important aspect of employment with Shanty Creek Resorts.
