Your personal essay, financial need, academic achievement and community service.

Guidelines

Eligibility

- Currently enrolled undergraduate or graduate students
- Non-Korean American/Canadian who want to study at Summer College of Ewha Womans University.

Benefits

- Tuition fees. Coverage of on-campus dormitory fees (double occupancy) may be provided, subject to the USD-KRW exchange rate.

Terms and Conditions

- The scholarship is awarded only to US/Canadian students of non-Korean heritage who study at the International Summer College of Ewha Womans University in Seoul.
- Scholarship recipient(s) must be resident in Korea during the entire period of the International Summer College.
- All scholarship recipients are required to submit a brief written report within 30 days of the completion of their program of study.

Application

- Applicant may apply for only one of the scholarships offered by the Foundation.
- Applicant must submit: application form; official college transcripts from currently enrolled in educational institution; one letter of reference; and a personal essay.
- Completed application (including all supporting documentation) must be received no later than April 5.

Special Notes- All applicants are required to read and understand the following guidelines before applying.

- Applicants must first submit their EISC application and complete the application fee payment.
- The application fee is non-refundable, even if the applicant is not awarded the scholarship or decides to withdraw.
- Applicants must be able to attend all courses for the full duration of the EISC program.
- Students selected as exchange students by their home institution are not eligible to apply for the scholarship.
- Students who receive other support (e.g., tuition, dormitory fees) from their home institution or other sources are not eligible for overlapping scholarship benefits.

*****Failure to comply with these guidelines may result in the cancellation of scholarship awards.***
