Privacy Policy for "Appointment Printer" Chrome Extension

We are committed to protecting your privacy. This Extension is designed with privacy in mind, performing its core functions locally within your browser.

1. Information We Access and Use

The Extension accesses two types of information solely to perform its intended function:

- Website Content (Appointment Data): When you explicitly activate the Extension by clicking the "Print Future Appointments" button on a webpage, the Extension runs a script locally within that active tab. This script reads the content of the current webpage to identify and extract details related to upcoming appointments (such as date, time, patient name, provider, reason, and status). This information is accessed only when you initiate the action and is used only to format the appointment list for printing. This appointment data is NOT stored, saved, transmitted, or shared by the Extension. It is processed temporarily within your browser for immediate display in the print preview tab.
- User-Configured Header: The Extension allows you to create and save a custom HTML header via the configuration page. This header content, created by you, is saved locally using Chrome's storage.sync API. This allows your header to be remembered across browser sessions and synced between your logged-in Chrome instances if you have sync enabled.

2. How We Use Information

- Appointment Data: Used exclusively to filter for future appointments and format them into an HTML list, combined with your custom header, in a new browser tab for you to review and print.
- User-Configured Header: Used solely to prepend your custom formatting to the generated appointment list before it is displayed for printing.

3. Data Storage

- Appointment Data: Not stored by the Extension.
- User-Configured Header: Stored locally on your device using chrome.storage.sync. This storage is managed by your Chrome browser. You can clear this stored header by reconfiguring it or potentially by clearing browser storage related to the Extension (or by uninstalling the Extension).

4. Data Sharing and Disclosure

We **do not** collect, store (except for the user-configured header locally), transmit, share, or sell any data accessed or generated by the Extension, including website content (appointment data) or your custom header configuration, with us or any third parties. All processing occurs locally within your browser.

5. Security

We rely on the security mechanisms provided by your Chrome browser and the chrome.storage.sync API for storing the custom header. We do not implement additional security measures as no data is transmitted off your local device by the Extension.

6. User Choices

- You control when the Extension accesses webpage content by clicking the "Print Future Appointments" button.
- You can configure, modify, or clear your custom header at any time via the Extension's configuration page (config.html).
- You can uninstall the Extension at any time through your Chrome browser's extension management settings, which will remove the Extension and its locally stored data (including the header).

7. Children's Privacy

The Extension is not intended for use by children under the age of 13 (or the relevant age in your jurisdiction), and we do not knowingly collect any information from children.

8. Changes to This Privacy Policy

We may update this Privacy Policy from time to time. We will notify you of any changes by posting the new Privacy Policy and updating the "Effective Date" at the top. We encourage you to review this Privacy Policy periodically for any changes.
