Note to authors: Articles should be between 3,000 and 10,000 words long (excluding references). Each article will be checked for plagiarism.

Articles should be typed in Microsoft Office Word format, using Times New Roman font, 12pt, and 1.5 spacing on A4 paper. The paper format is 4-4-3-3 (left-top-right-bottom).

Authors can submit and register articles via online OJS on the website by first registering and uploading the article.

The background must describe the purpose of the research and describe previous research and the problem solving that the researcher wants to solve as a solution both now and in the future.


