

FITTING THE HEAD

There are **2 pillows** inside the head; 1 at the forehead, and 1 at the top of the head. If you need to adjust the fit, both can be removed by velcro and stuffed further.





AFTER WEARING THE FURSUIT

• To prevent moisture buildup, wipe the inside of the head after use and air it out using a desk fan. Dryer sheets may be used to keep parts fresh inside.

- You plan to wear it multiple times in a day, you can lightly spray fur parts with an anti-bacterial spray (which has 1 part isopropyl alcohol and 1 part water) or an air freshening spray. It's recommended to do this at most once per day.
- If your head's hair is primarily wig, or very styled, it's recommended to place the head on a standing head mannequin when not in use.

CLEANING AND LONG TERM MAINTENANCE

- Clean fursuit parts such as necks / handpaws /feetpaws / tails with Folex or laundry soap and water. Avoid soaking foam pieces above 3 inches thick, as these will be harder to dry correctly.
- Hand washing is recommended for fursuits, but machine washing is safe if the fursuit is placed in a laundry bag. Do not dry clean the fursuit.
- After the bodysuit is clean, you may place it into a washing machine on a spin cycle to get out most of the water. Be sure to place in a laundry bag to minimize fur loss.
- Always air dry fursuit parts.
- Restyling the hair sometimes will be necessary. You can use a comb, brush, or
 fur brush on the hair. For hair tips or bangs, you can use either watered down
 clear craft glue, hairspray, or a little hair gel (Like Got 2B glued products.) Use
 any product sparingly as it will build up.

 If the hair becomes dirty or the product builds up too much, use a warm damp cloth and soap on the hair. Submerging the hair in warm soapy water may be necessary. (The fur on the face may get a little wet.)

PRECAUTIONS

- Fursuits that are tight, or have a lot of small pieces may incur popped seams with extensive use. This is easily repairable with hand stitching.
- Do not use fursuit spray or alcohol based cleaners directly on the eyes or areas that are airbrushed. Please use a water based wipe for those areas.
- Do not vacuum seal any fur pieces for longer than 24 hours.
- Creased fur can be steamed with a hand steamer and fur brush / comb. But be careful with applying heat to the fursuit, as burning fur is irreversible.

FURSUITING GUIDE

PUTTING ON THE FURSUIT

- This is the recommended order for putting on an entire fursuit:
 - Plug fan into battery inside head \rightarrow Insert padding into bodysuit \rightarrow Attach tail to bodysuit \rightarrow Put on bodysuit \rightarrow Put on feetpaws \rightarrow Put on head \rightarrow Put on handpaws \rightarrow Cover the ankles and wrists with sleeves \rightarrow Brush fur and hair
- Wearing full body <u>under armour</u>, a head balaclava and/or gloves is recommended for heat and sweat absorption.
- The fan's battery can stay within the head on a loop at the top of the forehead.
- If you wear glasses, apply an anti-fog spray beforehand. (Like <u>Jaws spit anti-fog spray</u>) If this does help with fogging, contacts may be necessary.
