- **OBTAIN PERMISSION FROM CURRENT EMPLOYER**

Request the present employer's consent to the transfer to the Ministry of Manpower's (MOM) FDW e-service. This action must be taken at least 30 days before the **transfer maid's work permit** expires. The **transfer process** cannot move forward without the existing employer's approval.

- **APPLY FOR A WORK PERMIT**

After getting the existing employer's approval, you can apply for the **transfer maid's work permit**. You will receive both the consent and an in-principle clearance from the MOM. Get a copy of the Declaration form from the MOM e-service, and make sure you and the maid both sign it properly.

- **SET THE TRANSFER DATE IN ADVANCE**

Contact the maid's current employer to decide on a transfer date. To guarantee a seamless transition, this stage is crucial. You may proceed to obtain the issuance of the new work permit on the agreed-upon transfer date. Print the temporary work permit after uploading the

completed declaration form using the MOM e-service. The **transfer maid** will then be able to start working for you.
