In accordance with Regulation 11 and Regulation 14 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012 (as amended), notice is hereby given that THE LONDON BOROUGH OF HACKNEY (“the Council”) adopted the The Dalston Plan Supplementary Planning Document (SPD) on 21st of March 2025 and produced an Adoption Statement to this effect.

The Dalston Plan is a supplementary planning document (SPD) that will support the delivery of the growth strategy for Dalston as set out in the borough-wide [Local Plan 2033](#) (LP33). The SPD is consistent with Hackney’s adopted Local Plan and other adopted local area action plans and in general conformity with the London Plan. The SPD is part of Hackney’s planning policy framework and will be a material consideration in the determination of planning applications.
