3. **AI in Cinematic Innovation:** AI may be utilized in cinematic coursework that explores innovative storytelling techniques, visual aesthetics and narrative structures. Students should seek clarification from instructors regarding the appropriateness of AI tools for specific assignments.
4. **Ethical and Responsible AI Use:** Students, faculty and instructors should prioritize ethical considerations when integrating AI into cinematic projects, avoiding the use of AI to compromise the authenticity of creative expression. The department encourages the exploration of AI's role in pushing the boundaries of cinematic storytelling responsibly.
5. **Accountability and Consequences:** Violations of this policy may result in academic penalties, ranging from grade reductions to more severe consequences, depending on the severity of the infraction.
6. **Educational Guidance:** Faculty and instructors are encouraged to provide educational guidance on the ethical and creative use of AI within the cinematic arts context.
7. **Continuous Review:** This policy will undergo regular reviews to align with advancements in cinematic technology, ethical considerations, and the evolving landscape of creative expression. Updates to the policy will be communicated to the Cinematic Arts community in a transparent and timely manner.
