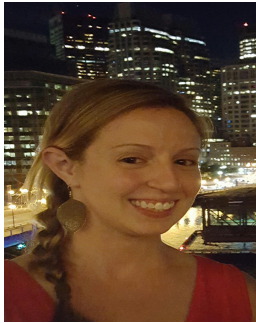
Lauryn Barker-Grade 4 teacher
