Advanced Ceramics

Course Description:

Advanced ceramics classes are project-based courses. Students will develop ceramic skills with an emphasis on the production of related pieces, large scale work, and advanced throwing technique. Specialty glazing, decorative finishes, and Raku will be introduced. Advanced ceramic studio assignments will be undertaken in accordance with the student's skill level and ability. Techniques learned will include various forms such as plates, bottles, belly pots, and lidded jars. Students will use these skills to create thoughtful ceramic pieces. Projects will include historical and methodical research and creation along with the study of processes and materials. Students will participate in the presentation and critique of their own work and the work of peers. Work will be placed on display throughout the semester.
