

ENDANGERED ANIMALS

Endangered animals are animals that are in danger of disappearing forever.

Polar bears are in danger of extinction because of global warming. If the temperature of the earth goes up, the ice where polar bears live will melt and disappear.

Elephants are killed for their tusks. Tusks are used to make expensive objects. Hunting elephants is illegal but there are many poachers that don't respect the law.

DESERTS
Deserts are usually hot and very dry. It's difficult for trees to grow and many plants are small. Many desert animals are nocturnal. It's colder and more comfortable for animals at night. Animals sleep during the day and hunt at night. They have two short legs, two long legs and a long tail. Their tails are longer than their bodies so they can jump and run to escape dangers. Camels, scorpions, snakes and lizards live in deserts too.

GRASSLANDS
Grasslands have lots of grass and some trees. They have a rainy and dry season. The dry season is longer than the rainy season. Grasses grow well in the grasslands and eat plenty. Leopards, cheetahs and lions hunt these herbivores. Gazelles live in the grasslands too. They've got strong legs and they can run faster than lions.

Two fascinating mammals

Mountain Gorilla

MOUNTAIN GORILLA

Mountain gorillas live in a small area of Central Africa. They live under the trees in cold, cloudy mountain forests. They mainly eat roots, shoots and stems of plants. Sometimes they also eat leaves.

An adult male mountain gorilla is as tall as an adult human man, but it is usually a lot heavier. In the wild it can live for about 35 years.
