Presented by Corner Bar Management, Cheapshot offers loose, live, and down 'n' dirty entertainment in Downtown Las Vegas at 517 E. Fremont St., Suite 100. Dressed in rich reds with touches of gold and soft lighting, Cheapshot reigns as the most intimate showroom and discotheque in Las Vegas, spanning 3,000 square feet with seating for 99. Elegant booths and plush seating surround the stage, which showcases a dynamic lineup of bawdy performances. Bartenders serve cheap, stiff drinks with a wink and a grin, setting the stage for a night of irreverent entertainment. Cheapshot is open 7 p.m. to midnight on Thursday; 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. Friday and Saturday; and 7 p.m. to 3 a.m. Sunday. Commonwealth

Commonwealth is the cornerstone of Downtown Las Vegas' hip bar scene, blending stylish social vibes with a mix of art and industrial architecture spread across two floors. Inside the 6,000-square-foot cocktail bar, crystal chandeliers hang from wooden beams, while original brick walls adorned with newspaper remnants whisper secrets of a bygone era. The rooftop bar features a DJ booth and dance floor surrounded by tables for lounging, offering 360-degree views of downtown Las Vegas. Mixologists craft signature and seasonal cocktails, and by night, Commonwealth transforms from its vintage charm into a vibrant club scene, hosting both national and international DJ talent. Located at 525 E. Fremont St., Commonwealth is open 10 p.m. to 3 a.m. Wednesday and Thursday, from 7 p.m. to 3 a.m. Friday and Saturday, and from 10 p.m. to 3 a.m. on Sunday. DISCOPUSSY

DISCOPUSSY, a 6,500-square-foot after-hours dance haven, brings mainline house and techno to Fremont East. Its centerpiece is a custom-built disco-octopus, composed of over 10,000 laser-cut components and illuminated by more than 5,000 individually addressable LEDs. Beneath this dazzling display, dance culture comes alive with a Void Acoustics sound system, as world-renowned producers and emerging underground DJs take control of the decks deep into the night. Paying tribute to the hacienda days of Detroit, New York, and London, DISCOPUSSY's inky atmosphere is brightened only by piercing lasers, the iconic octopus, and the electric personalities who frequent it. Located at 506 E. Fremont St., DISCOPUSSY is open 10 p.m. to 4 a.m. on Friday and Saturday, and from 10 p.m. to 2 a.m. on Tuesday, Thursday and Sunday. La Mona Rosa

La Mona Rosa, situated in Fremont East's Entertainment District at 100 S. Sixth St., celebrates Mexico's diverse and robust flavors. Recognizable by its namesake, a 7-foot pink neon monkey clinging to the restaurant and bar's exterior, La Mona Rosa captures the energy of downtown's eclectic nightlife combined with the spirit of Tulum with an indoor/outdoor dining room and bar, plus a streetside patio. Executive Chef Isidro Marquez-Castillo expertly prepares dishes that blend the traditional with the new. Highlights include cochinita pibil, a pork shoulder with achote citrus marinade steamed in banana leaf, served with pickled onions, habanero salsa, and heirloom corn tortillas; and pescado zarandeado, grilled fresh fish with citrus herb mustard, accompanied by avocado, pickled onion, pico de gallo, Yucatan tomato salsa, and heirloom tortillas. Ace mixologists complement these rich spices with refreshing libations like the Oaxacan Old Fashioned, made with mezcal, tequila reposado, agave, Angostura, and orange bitters. Brunch selections offer a cure for late Vegas nights with fun, flavorful tacos and oversized plates, such as papas con chorizo, featuring pork chorizo with fingerling potatoes, sunny side eggs, pinto-refried beans, and salsa molcajete.

The Laundry Room

Built into the original bones of a Bugsy Siegel-era laundry room in Downtown Las Vegas, The Laundry Room has remained the city's in-the-know spot for exceptional cocktails for over a decade. Top mixology talents devote meticulous attention to each singular cocktail, whether it's

one of The Laundry Room's lauded signature libations or a made-to-order concoction to fulfill individual desires. Tucked away inside Commonwealth, a popular Fremont Street bar, the 350-square-foot cocktail lounge keeps its intimate vibe by strictly limiting the number of guests to no more than 22 at all times. Gently lit by candles and a crystal chandelier, the room is filled with custom-made chairs and plush booths inspired by a turn-of-the-century sensibility. Vintage photographs and newspaper clippings line the walls, and a classic piano sits in the corner. Patrons must adhere to a strict set of house rules, which include no photography, PDA, standing at the bar, or speaking on phones. Currently on the menu are the Clunker, a bitter, zesty cocktail made with whiskey, bitter Italian aperitivo, cacao, lime, cardamom and chocolate bitters; and Fu'd Up Frunk, which highlights notes of fig and dates with dark rum, PX sherry, espresso liqueur, honey, lime, angostura and egg whites.

We All Scream is an exhilarating fusion of art-filled nightclub and not-for-profit ice creamery that supports public art. This 10,000-square-foot wonderland is a haven for music and art enthusiasts. The indoor-outdoor compound boasts a vintage dairy truck-turned-DJ booth powered by Void Acoustics sound systems on the ground-level patio, and a custom ice cream cone-shaped DJ booth embedded with LED sprinkles on the rooftop dance floor.
