**Position Overview:** The Three Forks School District is seeking a Foods Service Program Manager / Supervisor to plan, coordinate, and prepare food for students during our school and summer programming. This position will also be responsible for the planning and implementation of the Summer Community Foods Program. The person in this position will be responsible for planning and preparing nutritionally balanced quality meals for students attending summer and school year programming as well as the Summer Foods Program for the community. Due to on-going construction, meals will be prepared and served from our district mobile kitchen during the summer months. The building kitchen is scheduled to be completed for the start of school in the fall of 2022.

## **Essential Duties and Job Responsibilities:**

- Prepares, plates, and serves meals for students
- Adheres to food safety standards at all times, making sure that all food is free of contaminants and pathogens that might result in illness.

- Demonstrates excellent customer service with a positive demeanor
- Cleans pots, pans, and any other dishes in the kitchen as needed, adhering to safety and sanitation standards at all times
- Maintains accurate inventory of resources
- Creates menu for duration of summer and school year programming
- Manages and maintains supplies needed for meal preparation including food orders on regular basis

### **Desired Minimum Qualifications:**

Appropriate food handlers license or certification: Food Serve Safe Certification Supervisory Experience in Food Service Management Experience working in school setting food services preferred Knowledge of kitchen sanitations, cleaning, and maintenance Experience with technology, reporting, record keeping

#### **Equipment Used:**

A variety of all types of kitchen equipment including gas stoves, ovens, warmers, coolers, pots & pans, utensils for cutting, paring, slicing, and stirring.

#### **Work Environment:**

While performing the duties of this job, the employee regularly works inside a food trailer during our construction phase and then within the school facility in the fall of 2022. The employee must be able to meet deadlines with sometimes significant time constraints. The employee is directly responsible for the health, safety, well-being, and nourishment of students through the course of meal preparation and delivery.

#### **Mental/Motor Demands:**

While performing the duties of this job, the employee frequently exercises flexibility (ability to shift from one task to another). The employee frequently works within time constraints and maintains attentiveness intensity. The employee is frequently involved in social interactions which require oral and written communications.
