
Getting Access to Technical Analysis Charts from Tradingview


Tradingview provides their Technical Analysis Charting library only to regulated brokers and public project websites. The charting library's documentation is limited to authorised users only. Now, with that comes the part where we obtain the permission from Tradingview in order to use their charting library to startoff with our project.

Obtaining the Technical Analysis Charting Library

Go to https://in.tradingview.com/HTML5-stock-forex-bitcoin-charting-library/ and you'll be welcomed with a similar page like the one shown below



From there, Click on the **Get library** button in the Technical Analysis Charts section. You'll find a modal popup appear with a form. You need to fill this form in order to obtain your access to the charting library of Tradingview. The modal must be similar to the one shown below.



After clicking on the **Send request** button, you'll be contacted by one of Tradingview's employees regarding your need for the same. After specifying your need, you'll be asked to fill out their **Technical Analysis Charts Licence Agreement**. After filling out the agreement, you'll be able to view their charting library code on github. The link for the same is this

https://github.com/tradingview/charting_library and it takes around a day or two for Tradingview to process your request and grant you access.

If you see an error while loading this page, it clearly means that you are not authorized by Tradingview to view their charting library yet.
