It was definitely a teachable moment for me as a teacher and obviously for her because she now had to raise a child, so definitely like the coolest experience of my life as a teacher but definitely only one of those like 'oh my god what do I do?" I'm only 21 and I don't know how to raise a baby. So then of course, we talked to the right people in the building and we got her the help she needed.

Ella: Credit to Mrs. Urbanski by the way for the aha moment that we keep on saying. Anyhow... I have a question, has a student ever stolen anything from you before?
