- Whitewater rafting (up to class IV)
- Whitewater kayaking (up to class IV)
- Backpacking (5-6 days in remote locations)

Spanish proficiency is desired, but not required.

This is a paid, annual position with the opportunity for contract extensions each year. The teacher will have residential life and expedition duties.
