COVID-19 SAFETY PLAN for the 2024-25 school year

We are excited to welcome our students back to campus and have made preparations to do so in accordance with guidance issued by public health officials.

This planning document is dated July 11, 2024, and draws from the California Department of Public Health's COVID-19 Public Health Guidance for the [2024-25 School Year](#), which was issued on July 11, 2024.

The purpose of this document is to provide transparency to the school community regarding the school's safety plans. This plan is posted on the All Saints Day School website.

We will continually monitor developments around COVID-19 within our community and remain focused on meeting the guidelines and protocols recommended by public health officials.

COVID-19 vaccination is strongly recommended for all eligible people in California, including teachers, staff, students, and adults sharing homes with these members of our K-12 communities.

All students and staff are expected to stay home if they are exhibiting COVID-19 symptoms and should complete a brief health evaluation of their child(ren) at home, prior to their departure to school each day, to confirm that no symptoms of COVID-19 are present. Daily COVID-19 Self-Evaluation:

- If your child(ren) has any of the following symptoms fever > 100.4, cough, shortness of breath, body aches, headache, loss of smell or taste, sore throat, nasal congestion, nausea, vomiting, diarrhea, and exposure to COVID 19 **stay home** and contact your PCP for recommendations about testing.
- In the past 24 hours, has your child taken any fever reducing medications?

FACE COVERINGS

Per the updated [CDPH guidelines](#) issued on March 12, 2022, masks are no longer required.

RECESS/LUNCH

- All students will be expected to wash or sanitize their hands before eating, after eating, and upon returning to the classroom from recess.
- Weather permitting, students will eat outside with their class in a pre-designated area.
- Students are expected to bring their own snacks and lunch from home unless hot lunch is available and has been pre-purchased.



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ISOLATION FOR SICK STUDENTS

We will monitor students and employees throughout the day for signs of illness, and the nurse's station will be used to isolate students who start to show symptoms of illness. The nurse's station is near the front office and will be managed by members of the front office staff.

EXPOSURES AND CONFIRMED CASES OF COVID-19

It is recommended that families notify the school if their child tests positive for Covid-19 and was on campus during their infectious period.

They may return to school if their symptoms are resolved or improving, and they have been free of fever over 100.4, vomiting and/or diarrhea for 24 hours without the use of fever reducing medication.

We will no longer be conducting individual contact tracing.

In the event that there is an outbreak (>3 cases) within a classroom we will send a notification.

Exposed students may continue to take part in all aspects of school. Testing is at the parent's discretion.

Information about testing results and health information will be kept confidential and shared only with the Health & Safety office and Head of School as necessary. These plans will be modified and updated regularly to reflect any new guidance so we can continue to provide a safe and healthy environment to our children and employees.
