Did you know that 17 year olds can vote in the primary election on March 19th if they are going to be 18 years old by the general election date on November 5. They register the same way as everyone else: by going in person to the county clerk's office at the courthouse, online, or to a driver's license facility.

You can REGISTER AND VOTE at the county clerk's office up to and all through Election Day. They will be open Saturday, March 16, from 9-12 as well. You will need two forms of ID, one of which has your current address. Here is the link to register online. Have your driver's license available for any information needed.
