

WHSAA Parade Rules and Regulations

1. Please register for your float by sending an email to windsor.vt.alumni@gmail.com.
2. To qualify for judging, floats must be registered by June 1 of each year.
3. Floats are to be assembled and in designated places for the parade along North Main Street across from the Price Chopper no later than 9:30 a.m. Floats will be lined up by order of graduation year, following instructions from the chairperson and/or designated parade committee members. Please try to come into town from the north end to easily find and pull into your line-up spot, or make arrangements with private property owners to safely turn around. Do not use private property to turn around floats without permission, this has been a serious issue in the past.
4. Floats are required to have the theme and graduation year prominently displayed. Participation is limited to class members, their spouses, and children.
5. Drinking of alcoholic beverages or the use of drugs on or around the floats at any time, before or during the parade, are grounds for immediate disqualification.
6. YOU WILL BE DISQUALIFIED: Nothing is to be thrown from the float. Participants walking alongside their float may hand out candy. Safety monitors – such as “wheel walkers” must accompany each float.
7. If you have special effects, like water, etc, please be mindful of your audience.
8. All floats are to be judged by a point scale, ties will be broken by majority vote of the judges favorite floats. Judges will turn in their individual rubrics to a WHSAA worker to be tallied to prevent judging bias. Judges will not be WHS Alumni.

Floats will be judged by a panel of judges located throughout the Parade route from line-up to 802 Credit Union. When your float gets to the Windsor House, please slow down as your float is announced (stops no longer than 30 seconds allowed to keep parade flowing), so that judges there may inspect your handiwork and Windsor on Air can capture your “moment”! A copy of the judging form is attached to this document for you.

Cash prizes will be awarded for the 1st, 2nd and 3rd places. Winners will be announced at the common at 11:30.

There will be a Mandatory float representative meeting, please send at least one representative for your class/float to this meeting! The date is TBD, but will be in the week prior to the parade. The association will be in touch as we get closer. This should take no longer than 30 minutes. 5 points will be deducted from your judging if you do not send at least one person to this organizational meeting. Calling in to the meeting will be acceptable, please reach out if this will be necessary.
