Role play assignment instructions:

This assignment has two parts: one which you will do as a group, and a second part that is a personal reflection.

**PART ONE**: Two - three students from each country will work together to enact and record a role play based on one of the two scenarios provided: <u>Journey to Sharahad</u> (Global Edge) or <u>A Trip to Mintana</u> (Global Edge). Each group should organize to decide who will play the role of the Americans and who will play the role of the Sharahadians or the Mintanans

- Team A Journey to Sharahad
- Team B Trip to Mintana
- · Team C Journey to Sharahad
- · Team D Trip to Mintana

You can use Zoom (sign up for a free account at <a href="www.zoom.us">www.zoom.us</a> for free meetings up to 40 minutes long) or any other program to record your role play. One person from each group should share a link to the recording (Dropbox, YouTube) with the rest of the group. Try to keep the recording to less than 15 minutes long.

**PART TWO**: Each student should post a 2-3 page **individual** reflection on what he or she learned from the role play and the readings from this module. Be sure to address:

- What were some important differences in communication both verbal and non-verbal?
- What were some important considerations to conduct successful negotiations with the people from the other culture?
- What would be the best way to resolve conflict with the people from the other culture?
- What obstacles did you encounter during the negotiations, and how did you overcome them?
- Were your negotiations successful? Why or why not?

Please include a link to your recording AND references to the reading from this module.

NOTE: Students could also prepare in advance and present the role play during a virtual session instead of recording it; the individual reflection could be an asynchronous discussion or a group discussion during a synchronous meeting.
