 - a. Mr. Avery confirms that he has received follow up on both issues from last meeting

 - a. Linda Jackson - students in school during the pandemic, what is happening with students who are being promoted to the next grade
 - i. Kesha Wood - students will automatically move up through matriculation, the parent or ed rights holder should initiate a conversation about holding a student behind a grade through the school administrator or the student's counselor. Different options are available through various districts including tutoring, summer school, and credit recovery.
 - b. Vanessa Perez - When we have submitted an IEP request for assessment, and that assessment plan was approved. Student has transferred districts to Pomona, but nothing has moved forward on that issue.
 - i. Kesha Wood - The clock does re-set for IEP deadlines when the district transfer happens. In cases such as these when the process has stalled, the LACOE special education contact can provide support with the Pomona School District's special education department.
