As you begin to prepare for recruitment, we have provided you with a detailed packing list so that you don't forget anything you will need throughout the week of recruitment and for living in a sorority facility for the rest of the year. Please scroll to find the list(s) that pertain to you!

During Recruitment (if staying on campus):

- Toiletries/medications
- Styling items & makeup (if you use these items)
- Towel/robe
- Shower shoes/flip flops
- Shower Caddy
- Twin Bedding (twin XL) or a sleeping bag
 - Sheets
 - Comforter
 - Pillow
- Clothes for recruitment
 - Casual clothes for Orientation
 - Outfit for Community Round - Panhellenic provided t-shirt, your choice of bottoms, and comfortable shoes
 - Outfit for Philanthropy Round - Panhellenic provided t-shirt, your choice of bottoms, and comfortable shoes
 - Outfit for Membership Round - pants/shorts & a top, casual dress, romper, jumpsuit, shoes your are comfortable walking in
 - Outfit for Preference - any color, think what you might wear to a summer wedding or graduation
 - Outfit for Bid Day - shorts, pants, jeans, sneakers, you will be receiving a t-shirt with your bid so wear a top you can easily throw a t-shirt over
- Clothes for down time
- Pajamas
- Rain Jacket / umbrella (this is Seattle!)
- Comfortable shoes
- Hangers
- Wallet, money, and ID
- Electronics chargers (phone, computer, tablet, etc.)
- Laptop, tablet, or computer
- Book/activities for downtime and breaks in your schedule
- Snacks if you'd like for between meals

For Sorority House Living:

This is all just a suggestion we recommend purchasing as little as possible prior to moving in because you do not know what your space will look like and what you will need!

- Toiletries/medications

- ❑ Small number of personal items (no more than would fill a few shelves/sit on your desk space)
 - ❑ Framed photos
 - ❑ Keepsakes

 - ❑ You may be able to decorate your space, but we recommend waiting before you bring too much decor like lamps, rugs, lights, curtains etc.
