Madison County Prevention (MCP) is committed to providing a safe and positive experience for its virtual program participants. The YA Virtual Agreement outlines the behaviors expected of participants. MCP encourages good virtual citizenship while engaged in virtual programming.

It is the responsibility of the Participant to understand and follow these expectations.

- Adhere to YA Mission and Agreements.
- Be respectful of others. Use respectful language when communicating with others.
- Raise concerns respectfully as necessary.
- Be accountable for your actions.
- Advocate for needs, including requesting help or accommodation when needed.
- Fulfill program obligations and perform duties with integrity and authenticity.
- Responsibly use personally identifying information for virtual program purposes only.
- Dress appropriately when engaged in any video conferencing.
- Participate in the virtual environment to the same standard as a physical environment.
- Actively participate, listen attentively, and minimize distractions to others.
- Utilize all program content created and links to virtual conferences in accordance with its intended purpose.

The following behaviors may result in being dismissed from the program:

- Using inappropriate or disrespectful language.
- Engaging in or promoting any form of violence, harassment, or cyberbullying.
- Displaying or using inappropriate imaging, screenshots, and digital devices.
- Failing to comply with the Agreements.

Participants who fail to comply with the expectations outlined in this Agreement or other program specific responsibilities may be subject to disciplinary action. Disciplinary actions include, but are not limited to, verbal warnings, parental contact, corrective action plans, and/or being dismissed from the program.
