Are you ready to go under the sea with me? Over 115 students have worked tirelessly to

create the imaginative world of *Disney's The Little Mermaid* and bring its memorable characters to life.

The show opens a week from today, and this is one you truly won't want to miss!

Based on one of Hans Christian Andersen's most beloved stories and the classic animated film, *Disney's The Little Mermaid* is a hauntingly beautiful love story for the ages. With music by eight-time Academy Award winner, Alan Menken, lyrics by Howard Ashman and Glenn Slater and a compelling book by Doug Wright, this fishy fable will capture your heart with its irresistible songs, including "Under the





Sea," "Kiss the Girl" and "Part of Your World."

The original story has been adapted and performed on tv, stage, and screen as well as inspired works of art.

- In Denmark, a statue of the little mermaid was commissioned in 1909 by Carl Jocobsen after viewing a ballet based on the story and was placed in Copengahen Harbor.
- In 1961, Shirley Temple played the little mermaid on *The Shirley Temple Show*.
- In 1976, there was an adaptation of the story in a Russian film directed by Vladimir Bychkov.
- Disney released the animated version of the story in 1989 with original music by Alan Menken and Howard Ashmen.
- In 2007, "The Little Mermaid" opened on Broadway with additional music by Alan Menken.
- The story continues in May of 2023 with a live action movie directed by Rob Marshall starring Halle Bailey.


