

Birth Years/Birth Order in KNB

I've been seeing some confusion on character ages, so I thought I'd clarify in one nice big post that presents the info as clearly as I can.

Important notes: **knb does not have a canon year that it takes place.** All we know is that the main timeline is from April (chapter/episode 1) to February (epilogue; Kuroko's birthday 1/31 has passed, but 3rd years haven't taken college entrance exams yet). For the sake of clarity/not causing confusion, I'm going to theorize that chapter/episode 1 starts in April 2009 (the year volume 1 was published). A lot of dates match up with this year (holidays, events with set days, games/tournaments falling on weekends), but it is not canonically the start. You're actually just meant to assume that knb takes place in the present day, as the year is rather irrelevant to the story. So, just note that even though I'll be using specific years for this post, **none of these years are canonical, only the month/days are.**

****Extra/Last Game takes place the summer after the Inter-High the following school year after the main series ends.** Nash Gold Jr. and Jason Silver are said to be around the same age as Hyuuga and the other second years. Inter-High ends around August/September, which means Nash's birthday has passed, so I'm going to assume that means he's freshly 18, which would make him born in the same year as Hyuuga. Jason Silver is stated to be 18 on the wiki, but his birthday is in October, so that would make him 18 going on 19 and approx a year older than Nash so he'd be the same age as Kasamatsu and his yearmates. American schooling systems work differently than Japanese ones, with the typical enrollment cut-off date being October 1st. Again, this means Jason was born a year prior to Nash and would be a grade level above him (though both have presumably graduated high school already as American high schoolers typically graduate their 4th/senior year at approx. 18 years old or turn 18 before October 1st).

1: When do Japanese school years begin and end?

The first thing you need to keep in mind is that **Japanese school years begin in April and end in March**. Schools (worldwide) have enrollment cut-off dates, meaning that children need to be born before a certain date in order to enter into school once they reach the proper age. Enrollment cut-off dates are not based off of calendar years, but school calendars. Since school starts in April in knb, we can assume that the cut-off date is sometime in April, especially since this is the case in real life too. I'm going with April 2nd as the cut-off date; luckily no one was born on that day!

“Children who were born between April 2nd and April 1st of the following year are placed within the same grade”.

There is also no super long break between school years in Japan like there is in Western schools/America (in the US, you typically get around 3 months between school years. This is your summer break and lasts from mid/end of June to the end of August/beginning of September). In Japan, school ends in March, then starts again in April that same calendar year. Usually it's only a couple of weeks between school years.

“...spring vacation...last(s) around 10 days, from...March 25 to around April 5...The new school year starts in April, at the end of spring vacation”.

Different schools could potentially have different start/end dates, but beginning in April/ending in March is pretty much the standard nationwide.

2: How old are high schoolers in Japan?

First years in Japanese high schools need to be 15 going on 16 (if they haven't already turned 16 during those 10 days at end of March/early April).

So, assuming that knb theoretically takes place in 2009, this means first years would have to be born between April 2nd 1993-April 1st 1994, second years born between April 2nd 1992-April 1st 1993, and third years between April 2nd 1991-April 1st 1992.

High School First Years: 15 going on 16

High School Second Years: 16 going on 17

High School Third Years: 17 going on 18

Japanese high schools only go up to year 3. Japanese middle schools are also three years, so middle schoolers range from 12-15 years old.

Middle School First Years: 12 going on 13

Middle School Second Years: 13 going on 14

Middle School Third Years: 14 going on 15

3: When was everybody born?

Using our theoretical start date of knb beginning in April 2009, everyone in high school is grouped as the following, at the beginning of the series;

Third Years are born between **April 1991 to April 1992**

Second Years are born between **April 1992 to April 1993**

First Years are born between **April 1993 to April 1994**

Specific birthdays, not separated by grade level/year, can be seen listed from January-December here;
