

If you want a spin on things and want to test a seed created by some twisted minds, you might be interested in this. Options will be mutually agreed to by the runners for each race; however Normal difficulty must remain to preserve the default item pool.

Please consult the “universal rules” and note that the Fall Tournament will have the following clarifications (because the Spring Tournament is differently formatted).

Placed Items:

Group Stage -- Runners Each Secretly Place 2 Items, Volunteer Squad Collectively Places One Item, Random Discord Member Places One Item

2 Way Group Tiebreaker -- Runners Each Secretly Place 3 Items

3 Way Group Tiebreaker -- Runners Each Secretly Place 2 Items

4 Way Group Tiebreaker -- Runners Mutually Agree to Place Two Public Items, Runners Each Secretly Place 1 Item

Bracket Stage -- Runners Each Secretly Place 1 Item, Volunteer Squad Collectively Places One Item, Random Discord Member Places One Item

Item Placement Priorities --

Round 0: 4 Way Group Tiebreaker Public Placements are made public to ALL (Including Booth and Audience, this is an OPEN DISCLOSURE)!

Round 1: Runners Submit Picks to their Seed Roller. Once they are not in conflict, their picks are LOCKED and shall not change.

Round 2: The Volunteer Squad / Booth will submit their collective pick to the Seed Roller. This team is allowed to talk amongst themselves regarding their pick but MUST keep it quiet until the race is OVER (not until after the winner finishes as in previous events) either via remaining runners finishing or forfeiting. If a conflict is caused; the same information is made available as to the cause; but this team is EXPLICITLY FORBIDDEN from talking about this knowledge to the public until the race is over!

Round 3: The “Lucky Audience Member” picks as in Round 2.

Regarding Volunteer and Discord Placements -- Races MUST be scheduled by the runners 72 hours in advance. One of the runners, once the match has been scheduled, should have the Discord Bot pick a random Discord member for the seed to add an item placement. They are second priority pick to the runners. Once the Discord member is picked; a Stream Team is found. Preference in signups should be given to those who are NOT the random Discord member. Once the Stream Team is set; they collectively get their item placement to the Seed Roller. Ideally the seed is rolled 24 hours before the race at minimum.

In the case of NO RESTREAM: Here's how you do it. Get a Seed Roller and each runner picks an "Discord member" -- this satisfies the 6 items in pool to keep consistency. Runners are instructed to highlight their VoDs for a future VoDcast of the race.

Note, a placed bottle may have its contents specified, and “progressive items” may receive multiple placements (for example, placing both gloves).

Runners’ Initial Placed Item Selection MUST be completed at least 48 hours ahead of race time, and the seed roller will confirm that there are no conflicts between chosen items. In case of a conflict, runners will both be informed which conflict case occurred -- in which case a new set of placements must be submitted as soon as possible.

Deadlines:

You must schedule all matches within the allocated deadline unless you get an extension in which case you have until the updated deadline. Deadlines for this tournament are as follows:

Group stages: August 1-August 22

Brackets Round 1: August 30-September 6th

Brackets Round 2: September 7th-September 14th

Brackets Semifinals: September 15th-September 22th

Brackets Finals/Bronze Match: September 23th-September 30th
