



Elevate Youth Summer Camp 2026

TERMS & CONDITIONS

GENERAL

- All participants must adhere to the rules and regulations set by Elevate Youth.
- Cooperation with Elevate Youth officials and volunteers is required at all times. Please contact the Elevate Youth administrators if you have any concerns or issues.
- Dispose of any waste or recyclables in the designated bins.
- No food or drinks other than water are permitted within the court area during game times; designated eating areas and times must be used.
- Do not walk across or near the courts during active play.
- Elevate Youth is not responsible for any lost or stolen items.
- Elevate Youth will not be liable for injuries sustained during the Camp.
- School District 60 and North Peace Secondary School are not affiliated with Elevate Youth. In other words, this is not a School District-run camp.

CAMP OVERVIEW

- Four individual camps will be run over the following four weeks at a rate of \$250 + tax and fees **per** week:
 - Week 1 - July 20 - 24
 - Week 2 - July 27 - 31
- The Camp hours run from 9 am to 4 pm.

DRESS CODE AND EQUIPMENT

- All participants must wear appropriate attire and clean, non-marking indoor shoes for activities inside.
- Participants without proper attire or shoes may be required to participate in their socks or bare feet for indoor activities.
- Elevate Youth is not responsible for any personal equipment damaged during the Camp.
- Participants are expected to bring basic equipment: a backpack, lunch, snacks, non-marking shoes, a water bottle, sunscreen, and personal sporting equipment if they prefer to use their own (equipment is provided).



REGISTRATION AND FEES

- Registration must be completed and paid in full before the Camp start date.
- Spots are limited and will be reserved on a first-come, first-served basis upon payment.
- All fees are non-refundable except if the Camp is cancelled by the organizers, in which case a refund will be issued.
- Options for early drop-off and late pick-up will be charged \$100 for each week per option (\$20/option/day).
 - Regular drop-off: 8:45 - 9:00 am
 - Early drop-off: 7:45 - 8:45 am
 - Regular pick-up: 4:00 - 4:15 pm
 - Late pick-up: 4:15 - 5:15 pm

ELIGIBILITY

- The Camp is available to kids aged 9 to 14. Exceptions may occur, but only on a case-by-case basis.
- Participants are only required to be interested in learning the games and activities. No other prerequisites!

MEDICAL WAIVER

- By registering, parents/guardians confirm that their child is in good health and physically able to participate in the Camp.
- Parents/guardians must notify the Camp management of any medical conditions or allergies before the Camp starts.
- Elevate Youth and its staff are not responsible for injuries sustained during camp activities.

ASSUMPTION OF RISK

- Parents/guardians acknowledge the risks involved in physical sports activities and agree that Elevate Youth is not liable for any injuries or accidents that may occur during the Camp.
- Participants are expected to follow all safety instructions provided by camp staff at all times to minimize the risk of injury.

BEHAVIOUR AND CONDUCT

- Participants are expected to behave respectfully toward coaches, staff, and fellow participants.
- Any misconduct, bullying, or disruptive behaviour may result in immediate dismissal from the Camp without a refund.



CANCELLATION AND RESCHEDULING

- Elevate Youth reserves the right to cancel or reschedule sessions due to unforeseen circumstances, such as extreme weather or facility issues.
- Participants and parents/guardians will be informed in advance if the event is cancelled. Where possible, a makeup session will be offered. If not feasible, Elevate Youth may provide a partial or full refund at its discretion.

PHOTOGRAPHY AND MEDIA

- By registering for the Camp, parents/guardians consent to Elevate Youth's use of photographs and videos of the participants for promotional and social media purposes.
- If parents or guardians do not wish for their child to be photographed, they must notify the Camp management in writing before the Camp begins.

LIABILITY WAIVER

- Parents/guardians must sign an Assumption of Risk and Waiver of Liability Agreement before the Camp begins.
- Elevate Youth is not responsible for any personal belongings that go missing during the Camp.
- **Elevate Youth and School District 60 are not affiliated. "The participant agrees to indemnify and hold harmless School District #60 (Peace River North), as the facility, from any and all claims, losses, damages, liabilities, actions, causes of action, costs, and expenses that School District #60 (Peace River North) may sustain, incur, suffer, or be put to at any time directly or indirectly, by reason of any act or omission of the participant pursuant to this Agreement or by any acts of the camp operators."**
