### **Announcements**

New Neighborhood Officer Angie M!

Jack was unable to attend.

### **Neighborhood Officer Angie M**

Angie wants to represent neighborhood south of Park Ave

Question about whether Lafayette is a snow route? Could use more stop signs to slow traffic.

### **Mauria Tomlin Neighborhood Update**

Still working with city and MoDOT re: unhoused under overpass

- Unhoused are traveling here from downtown, i.e. after emptying encampments there
- Working with Health & Human Services how best to work with them
- Unsold food from Soulard Market understood to be unrelated to unhoused presence
- Mentions lack of transitional housing options in the area, makes very difficult to find places for unhoused to go

Alderman Ways & Means Committee budgeting processing is underway.

- Encouraging city residents to watch videos of proceedings online, also send comments or remarks to Mauria, or to the city's comment portal

Recycling collection from alley containers due start again this month, exact day still uncertain

### **Neighborhood Committees / Board of Directors**

Importance of working by committees: Safety, preservation, beautification, website creation/mgmt

Re: board member elections, current 3 year term for all board members elapses April 2023.

Outgoing board elects new board, per by-laws. We want to shorten board member term to 2 years going forward.

Transitional process is to recruit Neighborhood Officers to establish working relationship with existing board members.

Necessity to maintain transparency in this process. This doesn't happen simply on its own.

Poor Ben has to type these minutes furiously!

Important detail that board members bear legal liability for ultimate use of funds.

We need to look into board liability insurance.

### **Ideas for using money from Mardi Gras, etc**

Spending \$\$ for new website is already a consensus by existing board

Better Zoom equipment? Ben's poor laptop won't last forever.

Conduct a survey! Hunter Westbrook can put together an example online survey.

- Mailer or door hanger with QR code to point residents to survey
- Survey form will also allow respondents to add their own ideas to be voted on
- Try to also gauge why residents may have become disengaged with current neighborhood association, how to fix.
- Use survey to measure: resident satisfaction, degree of engagement, what things we spend money on

Neighborhood board is committed to using the money as informed by this survey/outreach effort, to extent feasible.
