

LESSON 6

Theme: “Starter. People and Relationships.”

Subtopic: “Traits of character. = Риси характеру.”

Expected results: The children will be able:

- to get acquainted with the new vocabulary;
- to practice use of the structure “used to” in various kinds of sentences;
- to read and translate the given dialogue guessing the meaning of the words in bold;
- to listen to the information and answer the questions to it;
- to use the video and describe yourself with its help.

Equipment: the book “English” 10th Grade by Oksana Karpiuk; the video from YouTube “Describe your character & personality”; the link to the Wordwall game based on ex.5, p.24; the audio to Ex.3 & 4, p.26; the list of the new vocabulary.

Procedure:

Greeting & Warming-up:

The teacher greets children and draws their attention to the theme of the lesson with the help of the illustration above.

Then she explains the meaning of the words they are going to deal with. The pupils are trying to give their translation without her help (p.26).

A: Do you ever **argue**?

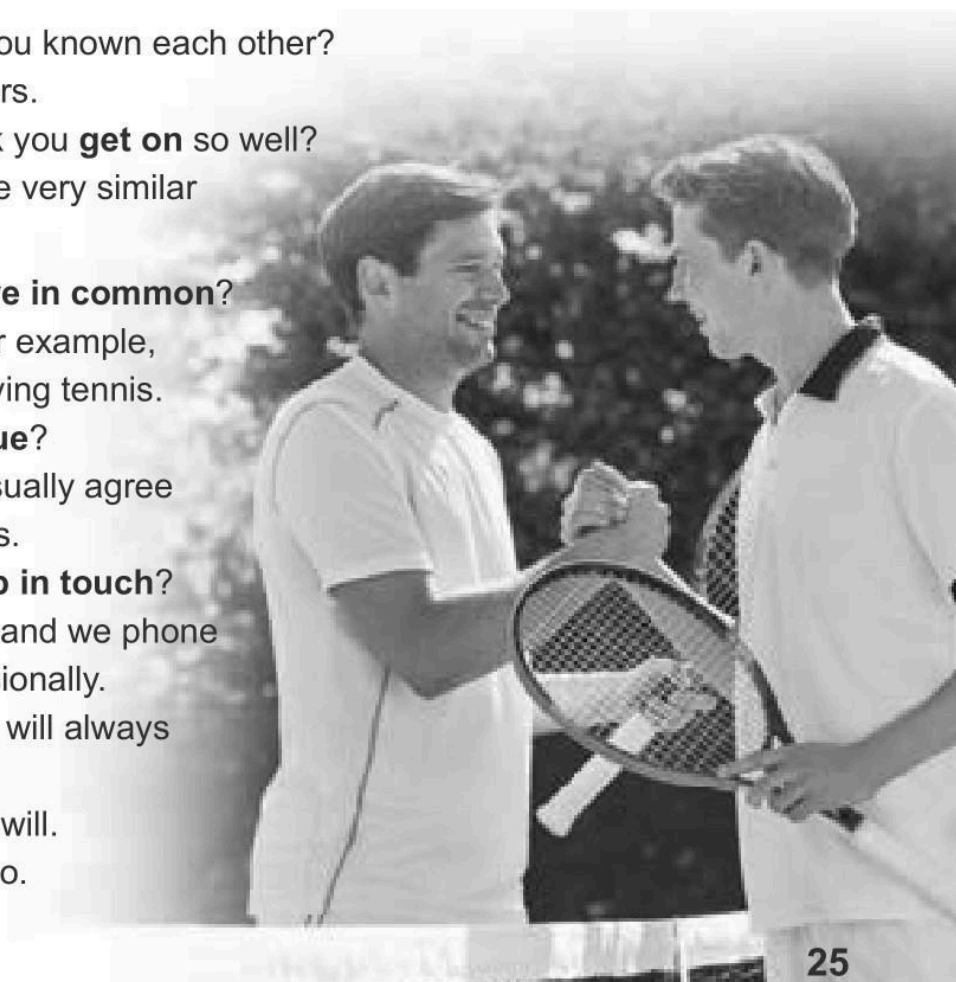
B: Not much. We usually agree about most things.
