Badminton Term Three 2025

The Intermediate School Badminton Competition is for both boys and girls and players play in a combined year seven and year eight grade. The competition is played during terms three and four. Each term is run as a separate competition.

Venue:

Badminton North Harbour, Forrest Hill and Constellation Drive.

Date and Time:

Boys Monday afternoons from **Monday 21 July**. It is an eight week competition and there is no play during the week of 1 September due to AIMS Games. Games are played between **4.00pm and 5.30pm**.

Girls Tuesday afternoons from **Tuesday 22 July**. It is an eight week competition and there is no play during the week of 1 September due to AIMS Games. Games are played between **4.00pm and 5.30pm**.

Sections (Grades):

There are two sections/grades, A and B. The A grade is for players who have played before and/or are in a club team. The B grade is for new players.

Fees and Registration:

The cost per player is **\$45**. Fees are non-refundable after teams are finalised and published. To register your child and pay the fees, please go online to [Kindo shop](#) and select "2025 Term Three Badminton Competition" under *Sports Teams Fees*. The online registration process needs to be completed by **5.00pm Thursday 19 June 2025**. Please make sure that you register in time, as late registrations cannot always be accepted. Only players who have registered in time will be put into a team. Please be aware that if you pay by bank transfer on Kindo, it often delays the registrations coming through to us. If you select this option and register close to the closing date, please email me to let me know that you have registered. kmaunder@tnis.school.nz

IMPORTANT:

Please consider the other commitments your child has on a Monday(boys) or Tuesday(girls). If they are already committed to another activity or class between 4.00pm and 5.30pm on those days, please do not register them for term three badminton.

Trials:

There are no trials for badminton. Everyone who registers in time is placed in a team

Team and Individual Registration options:

Learners are welcome to make up their own teams of 5 to 6 players. If you choose to make your own team, please make sure that you know the names of the other players in your team before registering on Kindo. During the registration process you will be asked to fill out the name and surname of the other players in your team. This is so we can match up your registrations when forming your team and when entering your team with the organisers.

If you do not have a team or only have two or three players, you will have the option to register as an individual. Please note this during the registration process on Kindo so that the school can try to help you make up a complete team. Please note that we cannot guarantee that we will be able to form a team for you, as it is dependent on the number of individual registrations received.

Managers and Supervisors:

Each team **MUST** have a parent volunteer to manage the team. The manager sends out reminders to the team, makes sure there are enough players each week and passes on any communication from the organisers and/or the school. If you would like to volunteer for the manager role, please do so during the online registration process. **Please note that teams cannot proceed in the league without a manager.**

IMPORTANT- One of the conditions of entry into the weekly competition, set by the organisers, is that each team must have an adult supervisor at their weekly games. This doesn't have to be the team manager each week. This can be shared between the parents. Please be prepared to take your turn and help with weekly supervision at the games.

Uniform:

TNIS PE uniform and suitable sports shoes. Learners need to have their own racket.
