Contents

By order of First President, Ethan Brinkman and Chairman of the Department of the State, Samantha Johnson and with respect to the wishes of the Executive Committee of the Office of the Presidency of the Arstotzkan Union, the Bureau of Finance of the Department of the State has established the following report and listed the findings of the Gross Domestic Product of the Arstotzkan Union. All figures are listed in AUC.

Private Consumption:

Analysis of Private consumption in the Arstotzkan Union has shown that our nation does not have any form of trade or goods purchasing in place established and therefore the Private consumption is listed at zero.

Gross Private Investment:

Similarly, to Private Consumption, it is noted that this section is also at zero. The Arstotzkan Federal Government and prior governments have never made any attempts to fund any investments into the Arstotzkan economy nor infrastructure and thus GPI is zero.

Government Investments:

In 2022, the Arstotzkan Federal Government aided in the formation of a private, limited liability company known as **Ormsby – Miller Production Studios LLC** and granted funds totalling ¢25. Investments into the purchase of weapons and vehicles for the People's Armed Forces of the Arstotzkan Union totalled ¢87,130.13 (2022 MSRP).

Government Spending:

In 2022, the Arstotzkan Federal Government aided in the formation of a private, limited liability company known as **Ormsby – Miller Production Studios LLC** and granted funds totalling ¢25.

Exports

Considering the primary and single export of the Arstotzkan Union is labour in New Zealand and the United States, the Arstotzkan Union exported a total of ¢326,973,600 in labour across the allied nations. The labour hours were considered at a baseline of 30 hours at ¢22.80 for younger workers and averaged around ¢180,000 for higher income earners.

Imports

Factoring the Arstotzkan Union imports everything for a functioning nation, the total for imports was valued at ¢156,443,000. This was calculated based on cost of living in New Zealand and United States.

Totals

This leaves with a total of ¢170,617,780.13 as the total GDP for the Arstotzkan Union. The GDP per capita, works out to ¢70,328.85. This was calculated by dividing the total GDP by the population and give us that total.
