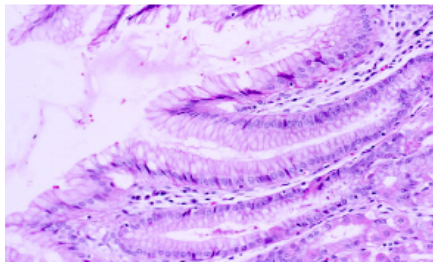


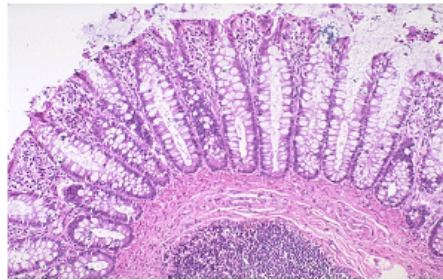

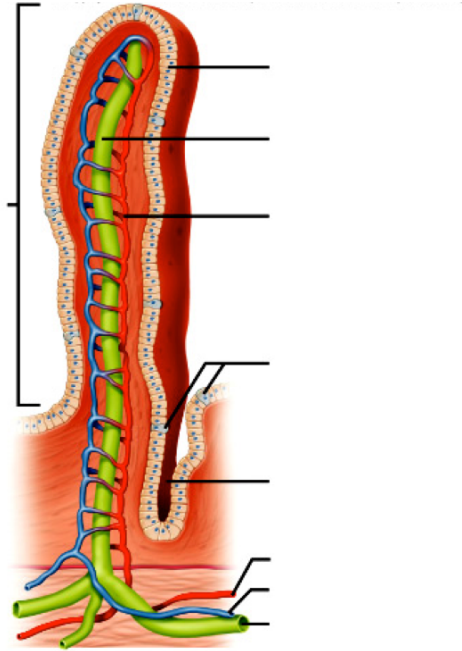

Blood capillary network

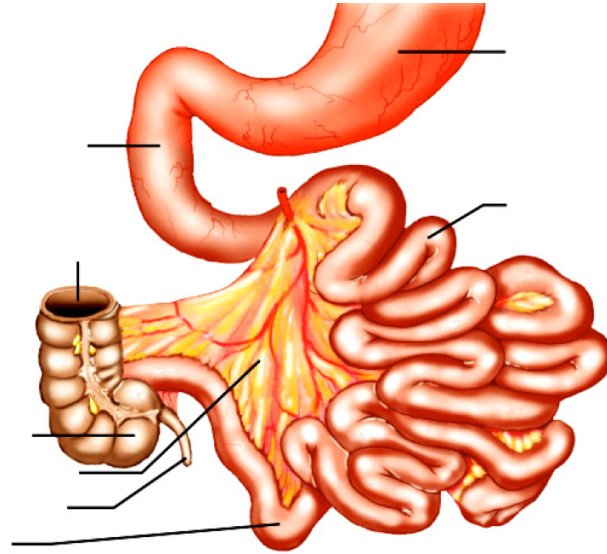

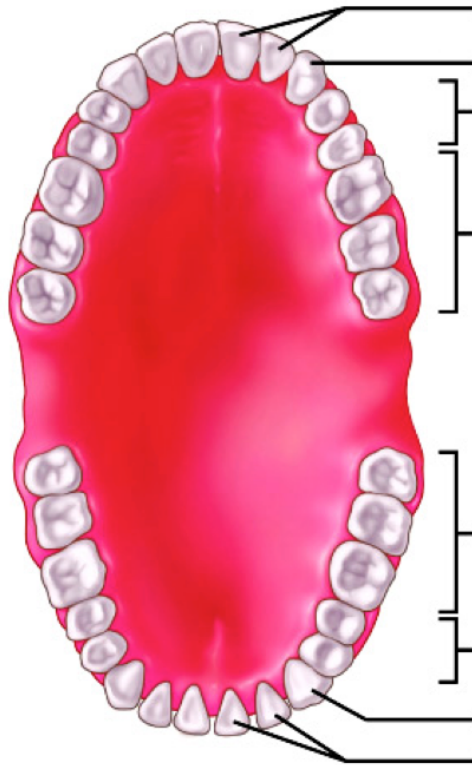

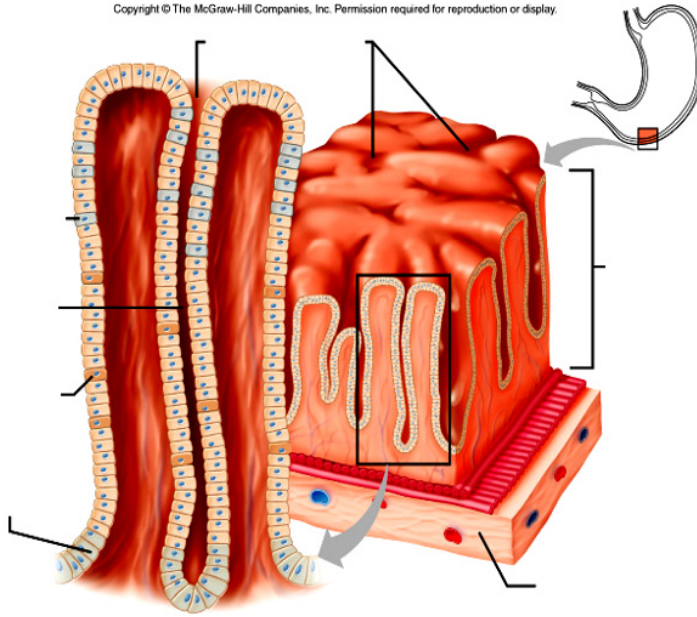
