Submission Guidelines

When can I submit my poetry to the zine?

Submissions will open on **21st April** and close on **31st May.** Please submit your work to therewillbepoems@gmail.com!

How should I submit my poem?

Please send your poem as an email attachment. Include the name under which you want your poem to be published and, if you would like, a social media handle. Anonymous submissions are also welcome!

How many poems can I submit?

As this is our first zine and we want to include as much work as possible, we are limiting submissions to one poem per person.

What kind of poem can I write?

We welcome all forms of poetry! The only rule is that your **work must be inspired by AMC's** *The Terror* (2018). Feel free to be as creative as you like around this prompt: take inspiration from a character, a setting, an object, a line of script...

How long can my poem be?

For guidance: poems shouldn't be longer than **30 lines typed**. This is to fit within printing guidelines. However, we want to encourage creativity in all forms, so if this will restrict you, please contact us and we can discuss options!

What if I have already written a poem that I'd like to submit?

As long as your poem has not been submitted or published elsewhere (including social media), you can submit it to the *There Will Be Poems* zine. However, throughout the submission period we will be posting **poetry prompts** and running some **open, voluntary workshop sessions** so you might be inspired to edit or start something new!

Work which is racist, sexist, homophobic, transphobic, ableist or otherwise bigoted will not be included in the zine.
