Important Information:

- Midyear exams account for 10% of the final grade in each course.
- Exams will be written in classrooms.
- Students must come prepared (pencil, eraser and any other necessary supplies as indicated by their subject teacher).
- Students are expected to arrive on time. We are unable to accommodate extra time for students who arrive late to an exam.
- We are committed to providing a quiet space for all students to write exams. In order to reduce disruptions to each classroom, students are expected to stay in their exam room for the duration of the exam. If students need to sign out, we ask that they do so at the end of the exam period. We appreciate your support in this! Please contact the office with any extenuating circumstances.
- Cell phones, smart watches, and other smart devices are not permitted on students' person during the exam. These devices should be secured in lockers or left at home.
- Regular classes will go ahead during the exam period. When students are not writing exams, they should be in attendance for regular classes.
- During the exam periods listed above, Math, ELA, and Science teachers will be supervising exams and may not be present in their regularly scheduled classes. If students have questions regarding exam material, we encourage them to speak with their teacher prior January 28.
- If, due to extenuating circumstances, a student is absent from a midyear exam, the parent/guardian must contact school administration with a rationale for the absence. A new date will be provided for valid absences.
