I. INTRODUCTION [Times New Roman 12pt, Bold]

Give an adequate background of the problem you are solving. Avoid overly detailed literature review, draw a summary of the results. Explain how you solved the problem, and explain your goal. When writing the introduction, make it understandable to readers who are not experts on the subject. Use a narrative format and avoid sub-chapters.

II. MATERIAL / METHODS [Times New Roman 12pt, Bold]

Explain in detail about the research design, timing, variables, population, sample, sampling, instrument, data analysis, and information on passing the ethical test.

III. RESULTS [Times New Roman 12pt, Bold]

The results presented must be sequential from the main results to the supporting results. Use units of measurement based on applicable international standards. You can add diagrams, tables, pictures, and graphs by completing them with narration.

Figures and tables are placed at the end of the manuscript following the following rules:

- 1) Figures, tables, and diagrams must be editable;
- 2) Title of the figure and table is written at the top with times new roman 11, single space;
- 3) Narrative figures and tables are written at the bottom of the tables and figures;
- 4) Fill in the table using times new roman 11, single space.

Writing is based on the Author-Year notation system. All references mentioned are written according to the rules of APA Style edition 7, published in the last 10 years and in alphabetical order. References from journals are endeavored to include DOI. Reference writing is expected to use an electronic citation system such as Mendeley, EndNote, or Zotero.
