## Othello Act IV Tableaux

In finishing Act IV for today, we read two very intense scenes as the tension rises in the play. Today you will work with a group to create a tableau, which comes from a French term that means "living picture." The goal of your tableau is to present how the characters see each other in these moments.

- Each person playing the role of a character will first freeze into his/her own pose, reacting to what is most important in the scene to him/her.
- This is a silent tableau so, you will not say anything until we ask you to recite the lines you chose.
- After the audience has a moment to absorb this "living picture" of the scene, each person who was not a posed character will explain the character's point of view <u>and use a piece</u> of textual evidence to demonstrate where this interpretation comes from in the text.
