Topics

- Ashley Davis : New roadmap item: Post-quantum cryptography in cert-manager
 - Ashley to create a roadmap PR to add general intention to support PQC. No fixed timelines since we depend on upstream Go to add support first
 - Trilok shared that he'd spoken to some who wanted PQC, showing a demand for the feature
- Ashley Davis : cert-manager LTS updates
 - Ashley shared that Venafi / Cyberark don't intend to sponsor another LTS release.
 - 1.12 LTS will continue to be supported until its previously announced EOL in May 2025
 - Maintainers will also look into testing upgrades from 1.12 LTS to a more recent version (which matches discussions in recent cert-manager daily standups)
- Ashley Davis : cert-manager OLM bundle updates
 - Current intention is for cert-manager to stop producing OLM bundles because the ROI doesn't seem worth it to maintainers and it's a bit of a one person show
 - Trilok was interested in usage numbers, but we're not sure if we have them
 - Ashley to link up interested parties for further discussion if needed. Assumption is that maintaining OLM bundles will stop, but there's a chance Red Hat or others could step in
