Purposes: Develop advanced knowledge and leadership skills for helping all students through designing and directing targeted interventions

Endorsement Courses: Six required. All classes are **fully online** with synchronous sessions meeting between 5pm and 8pm during the academic year and 4pm and 8pm during the summer.
