HEALTH

Crestview strives to keep all of our children and adult staff healthy and active. We concur that our students need to be in school to learn. However, in order for our children to perform well they need to be healthy. Because of this, we find it necessary to solicit our parents' assistance in providing a healthy and safe learning environment. To achieve this, there are a few basic guidelines we need to follow to minimize the spread of illness in our school. Therefore, if your child has any of the following symptoms, please keep him/her at home:

- Temperature of 100 degrees or greater
- Diarrhea
- Vomiting
- Pink Eye (Conjunctivitis)
- Uncontrolled Coughing
- Difficulty Breathing
- Unidentifiable Rash
- Severe Cold with Fever
- Any Contagious Disease
- Generalized sick appearance with no obvious symptoms

In the event your child should become sick during the school day, the Office will call and ask that the child be picked up. If your child has any of the above mentioned symptoms the child must be symptom free for 24 hours before returning to school.

In the event your child contracts a contagious illness, such as Chicken Pox, Measles, Hand, Foot & Mouth Disease, Fifth Disease, Scarlet Fever, Impetigo, Pinworms, Mumps, Strep Throat, COVID-19 or Head Lice, the Office should be notified to ensure the appropriate communication is sent home with the students in your child's class.

Please be advised that Crestview follows all local, county, and state of California laws as it relates to COVID-19. This includes masking and vaccination requirements for its students. Crestview may also impose stricter guidelines as it deems necessary to protect its students, faculty and staff. As a result, while every parent has the right to choose what is best for their child, any refusal to abide by Crestview's COVID-19 protocols will result in the dismissal of such student from Crestview. Any pro-rated tuition paid in advance may be refunded at Crestview's discretion.

The Office should also be advised if your child has traveled/visited areas in which outbreaks of infectious diseases are present.
