Template 1: Yearly Overview Timeline

Junior Year

September – December
Research & Exploration:
☐ Begin exploring college options.
Attend college fairs and informational sessions.
Test Preparation:
Start preparing for standardized tests (SAT, ACT).
Consider taking a practice test to gauge readiness.
Initial Counseling:
Meet with your school counselor to discuss academic goals and potential college paths.
Summer Before Senior Year
June – August

Start brainstorming topics and drafting ideas for college essays.

 Request your official transcripts and ensure test scores are sent to your chosen colleges.
November – December
Application Submission:
☐ Complete and submit early decision/early action applications if applicable.
Continue polishing and finalizing regular decision applications.
Review & Follow-Up:
Double-check that all components (essays, recommendations, transcripts) are complete.
January – February
Final Applications:
☐ Submit any remaining regular decision applications.
☐ Confirm receipt of all materials with your prospective colleges.
March – May
Decision Time:
Review acceptance letters, financial aid packages, and scholarship offers.
 Make your final decision by college comparison and campus visits.

☐ Complete enrollment procedures and submit any required deposits.
