
Students can access or create their student account <u>HERE</u>. Please remember to have students use a personal email address, not their school email address. Students are encouraged to note their login credentials for future use.

Period 3/no 4th period -	9:11 - 9:59 - Online with teacher for instruction 9:59 - 10:46 - The teacher is available for questions/emails but students are not required to be online
A - Lunch - everyone	10:46 - 11:24 - Regardless of the day, Blue or Gold, everyone has this break
Period <mark>5</mark> /6 -	11:24 - 12:12 - Online with teacher for instruction 12:12 - 12:59 - The teacher is available for questions/emails but students are not required to be online
Period <mark>7</mark> /8 -	1:05 - 1:53 - Online with teacher for instruction 1:53 - 2:40 - The teacher is available for questions/emails but students are not required to be online

- On non-weather related closings (i.e., November 7 and May 7) we will use the
 above schedule, and staff will report to work on those days. Attendance is taken
 in each class and reported as normal.
- March 6 is a scheduled Asynchronous day where staff will report to work, and we
 will test the Junior class (SAT Test). With Asynchronous days, we post work
 for students to do and respond to emails as time allows, no official face
 time online.
- If we have a weather or emergency closing and we go to an eLearning day, we
 will use the above schedule for whatever color day is scheduled for that day. Staff
 will not come to the building on those days unless directed (custodians,
 secretarial, administration).
