III. ACTION ITEMS:

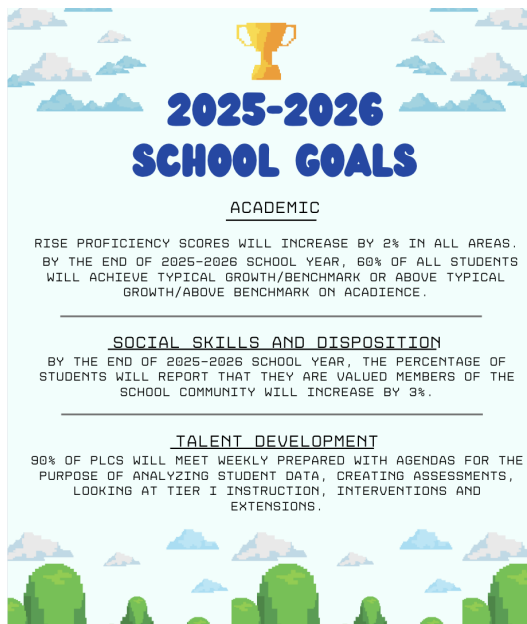
- a. Amend Land Trust Plan
 - Current Plan:
 - Goal statement: During the school year 2025-2026, Jim Bridger students making typical or above typical progress as measured by Acadience Reading and Math assessments will increase by 5% compared to 2024-2025 end of year Acadience Reading and Math scores (54%-59% in ELA and 50%-54% in Math).
 - Academic Area: ELA and Math
 - Measurement: Goal will be monitored using Acadience BOY, MOY, and EOY data, regularly evaluating Progress Monitoring data and other formative assessment data.
 - We will use Land Trust Funds to pay for half of a lower grade (1-3) classroom teacher. (\$43,664.69)
 - Amend Plan: Paraprofessionals working under the direction of teachers will be hired to work with students in Tier 2 reading intervention groups based on identified needs.
