Apply to schools of your choice—most schools have priority deadlines ranging from Oct. 1 –Feb. 1 depending on the school and major applying to
Double check your transcripts for mistakes and to make sure you have the necessary courses for admission
Start asking for letters of recommendation for scholarships and college admissions
Keep track of application deadlines for admissions
If you will be playing athletics for the NCAA you must register with the clearinghouse now
